

Your questions answered

A few of our parents/carers have asked similar questions, so I thought it might be helpful to share our school response.

- As previously stated, pupils cannot wear a blazer. We have now taken the decision that they will not wear a tie either.
- Key worker children who remain in school after the holidays will also be required to wear school uniform.
- Key worker children will attend between 9.00 am - 3.30 pm as usual, until their year group returns to school. From that point, they must attend at the same time as the rest of their group.

Friday 12.30 pm finish

From the first week back after half term, school will close to ALL pupils at 12.30 pm on a Friday. There will be an early lunch and all children will be fed. This is to enable us to deep clean the building. It will also give time for teachers to plan lessons and respond to online learning for pupils who are not in school.
